If you do not have a key for the local garbage compound, Please ask for one at the office. The bins are for household garbage only. The Compost pile is for loose leaves and grass. Do not put plastic bags or anything that will not break down in the compost pile. The Municipal Landfill is for all other garbage.

Summer Landfill hours are Wed & Sat 9am – 5pm
Sunday 12pm – 5pm

If a holiday is on a Friday or a Monday the landfill will be open the Monday 12pm – 5pm

Winter hours November 1st – March 31st are Sat & Wed – 10am – 3pm

Boathouse Update

We informed you in our last newsletter that we had a judgement ordering Schafer to remove his boathouse by April 1st unless mutually agreed on a later date. We agreed to give him and Schmidt until June 1st, 2009 to remove their boathouses if he did not appeal.

This was agreed and signed by both lawyers. **Schafer has now applied to appeal.**

The Romashenkos applied for an interlocutory injunction so they would not have to take their boathouse down until his case goes through the courts and was granted an injunction for one year. This does not mean they won their case.

We want everyone to understand, we are doing our job in demanding these three boathouses be taken down because they were illegally built. We are not suing them, they have sued us so we must defend ourselves.

We want to make it very clear there is no truth in the rumour that if these boathouses are removed, all boathouses will have to be removed.
